



Joint Undergraduate Mathematics & Physics Scholarship at GW

JUMP is a program that provides scholarships for talented GW undergraduates who have financial need. It is run jointly by the Department of Mathematics and the Department of Physics at GW, and is supported by a grant from the National Science Foundation.

JUMP participants will have the opportunity to participate in the JUMP seminar, allowing them to interact with faculty, other students, and industry professionals.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a United States citizen or permanent resident;
- Demonstrate financial need as defined by the FAFSA application;
- Intend to elect a major in mathematics or physics;
- Be enrolled full-time (12 or more credits) during the semesters receiving support.
- Preference will be given to current freshmen and sophomores
